

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Advanced Flooring Concepts LVT Products are engineered to withstand scratches and dents from everyday living. Our mission is simple: to make good floors better! If you follow the steps below your floor is going to look good as new for years to come.

| Good Practices | Bad Practices |

| Sweep the floor regularly with a soft bristle broom to remove loose dirt | Pouring Bleach on the floor and mopping vs applying bleach to a rag and spot cleaning dirty areas |

| Wipe the floor with a Microfiber cloth or damp mop | |
| Clean spills as quickly as possible and rinse with water | Drag, push or pull the furniture across the floor |

| Use Protective Pads | Use a Vacuum with a rotating beater bar |
| Use Walk-off mats for extra protection | Over Saturate the floor with too much cleaner |

CLEANING & MAINTENANCE

After installation — Use a dry cloth or vacuum cleaner for cleaning. When water or any cleaning liquid is used, please squeeze out all water before cleaning.

Harsh Cleaning Agents:

When you have tough stains to remove you can use bleach, denatured alcohol, urethane cleaning solution, or acetone, designed to remove stubborn areas. We recommend spot cleaning with harsh cleaning agents, and not pouring on the floor and mopping.

Never use scouring agents, polish, or wax as they may dull or distort the finish.

ADDITIONAL CARE TIPS

Furniture Protection: Use felt pads or furniture coasters under all furniture legs to prevent indentation and scratching. Replace worn pads regularly.

Temperature & Humidity: Maintain indoor temperature between 55°F–95°F (13°C–35°C) and relative humidity between 35%–65% to prevent expansion or contraction.

Sunlight Exposure: Prolonged direct sunlight may cause fading. Use window coverings or UV-filtering glass in areas with heavy sun exposure.

Spill Response: Blot spills immediately with a clean, dry cloth. Do not rub. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly.

Periodic Deep Cleaning: Use a commercial LVT floor cleaner diluted per manufacturer instructions. Avoid oil-based cleaners, wax, or polishes.
